Next Monday the newly founded vienna theatre project (vtp) will debut in the theatre in the Drachengasse in Vienna with David Mamet’s “Oleanna”. A play about a dialogue between a female student and her male professor which turns into “a modern reprise of the Inquisition”, as artistic director Martin Buxbaum puts it. The vtp was founded to facilitate high-quality English-language theatre productions at different venues in and around Vienna.
