

2004/05 season: vtp goes to the park

Auditions are held this Sunday

The vienna theatre project is searching for actors for its 2004/05 season's plays, which also include Shakespeare.

For the vienna theatre project's (vtp) upcoming third season Artistic Director Martin Buxbaum and staff are preparing five plays: The comedy "The Nina Variations" by Steven Dietz, a modern version of Shakespeare's "Two Gentlemen of Verona", the very emotional "Iz" by Oliver Emanuel and the funny musical "I Love You, You're Perfect, Now Change". Summer 2005 will see the start of the vtp's series "Shakespeare in the park" with the original "A Midsummer Night's Dream".

Actors required

On Sunday, June 20, general auditions for the vtp's 2004/05 season will be held. Actors of all ages are encouraged to apply. Native or native-like English is required for all or at least most parts.

Casts are still needed for two-week runs each at different 1st-district theatres in early November 2004 and March 2005 plus an open-air production in August 2005. The auditions will be held on Sunday, June 20, at the Ensembletheater am Petersplatz. Actors are required to prepare two short monologues (one Shakespeare and one contemporary - 1995 or later) and the directors want to know about any singing and/or dancing background. You will be assigned an audition time via email.
