Emotions on the run

vtp presents Levine's "Territory"

When Maya and Ben are visited by their weird friend James, love turns to doubt, suspicion to hate (however brief), friendship into affection and exaggeration is exposed as a cry for help. Feelings all three have fled from for a long time suddenly are laid bare by Ben who enters the scene as well as James and Maya's lives wearing a gas mask.

For the European premiere of the play, the head of the vienna theatre project (vtp) and producer Martin Buxbaum and director Juliane Langebach (once again) found three very talented young actors: Austrian-born Margit Atzler, Michael Smulik, originally from South Africa, and US-born Dave Moskin, who have all lived in Austria in the last several years. Moskin especially convinces as the "I could have been a wacko"- James. Atzler and Smulik successfully convey the feeling of a couple that might have been together a little too long for comfort - especially with some secrets between them. If you like to be led onto sometimes unsafe and definitely unknown emotional territory go and see the vtp's production.

Performances are Monday to Saturday at 8pm until March 17 in the "dietherater Konzerthaus".
